Training: To begin June 2024. So far four students have applied. More expected as the weather warms up. Should be another productive season.

Heli Fun Fly Mowing: The rains have boosted the growth throughout the flying site. Mowing will commence and work its way down the runway and in parking areas. The rain continues to regrow the vegetation. Will need to monitor the situation.

Valley Center Site: A for sale sign was placed on the property. The owners anticipate no offers but did so to show the legal availability. Extensive discussion was given to when and how to proceed with the development of the site so as not to create a conflict with the county. George Dawe is on the case as he was with our current field.

We have a FRIA approval. EPA will take some time. We have to be patient with this process as any conflicts could be harmful and consequential.

FAA trust enrollment must be completed by April 1. If these requirements are not met, pilots will not be allowed to fly. Further discussions will be held at the club meeting. Emails will be sent to those that did not comply. **All member must have their AMA and FAA secured and paid for by May, 2024.**

On Tuesday, April 16, 2024, there was a fire in the jungle. One of our members had, what we believe, their 200 amp ESC catch fire which led to an unresponsive aircraft which struck a tree and landed at the edge of the jungle. The 12-S battery packs ignited causing a number of trees to catch fire in the jungle.

Cal Fire was called and responded quickly so that the fire would not spread.

Fortunately, the fire was contained quickly but the aircraft was a complete loss.

As the plane was flying east over the far end of our field toward the jungle, Charlie Lewis and I were sitting in the pits watching. Suddenly, we saw a smoke trail, and thought it was intentional. When the smoke became black we realized the plane was burning inside! It rounded the top of the tree where the airplane is hanging but hit the top branch which brought it down. Soon there were billows of smoke and flames! Big flames! High flames! The fire department came and doused it. In a later photo you can see one of the planes’s wings stuck in a tree. At the top of the tree is a model plane and at the bottom near the flames is a grey wing.







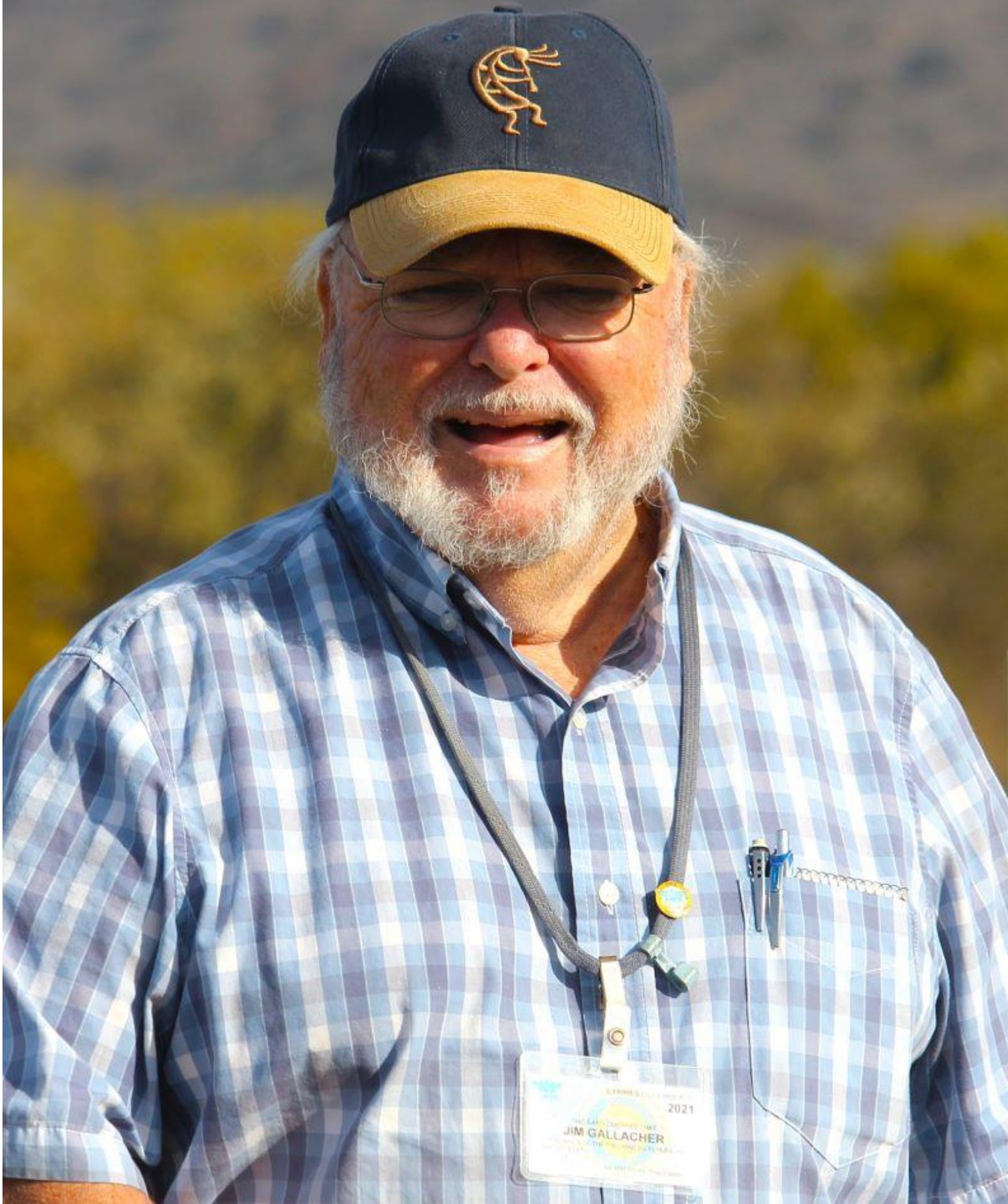

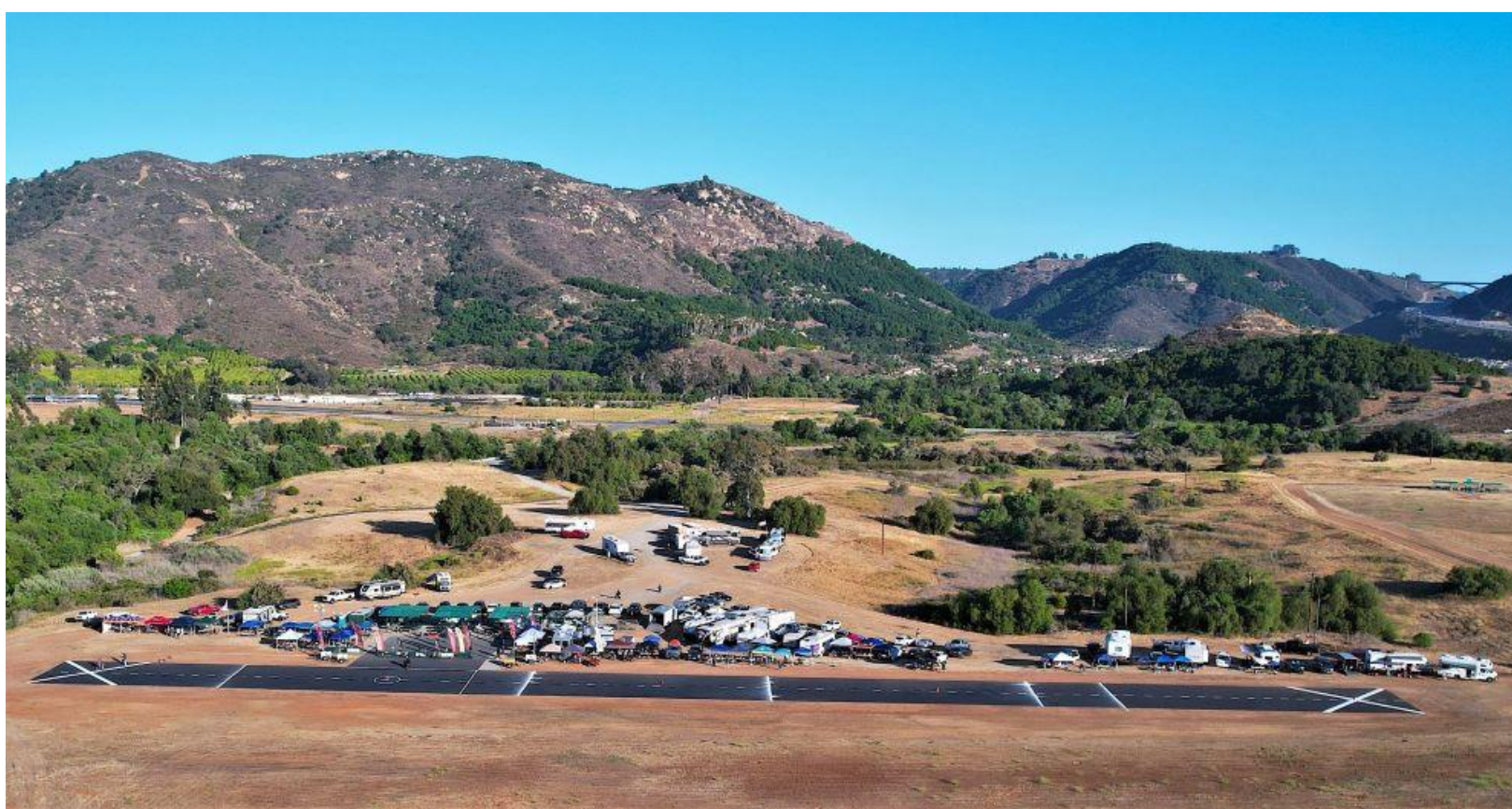


Is this a steamboat? Some say Scott Ralston was on fire and burning. Others say he is a fireman. Some say he is smokin' hot!

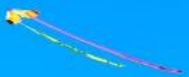

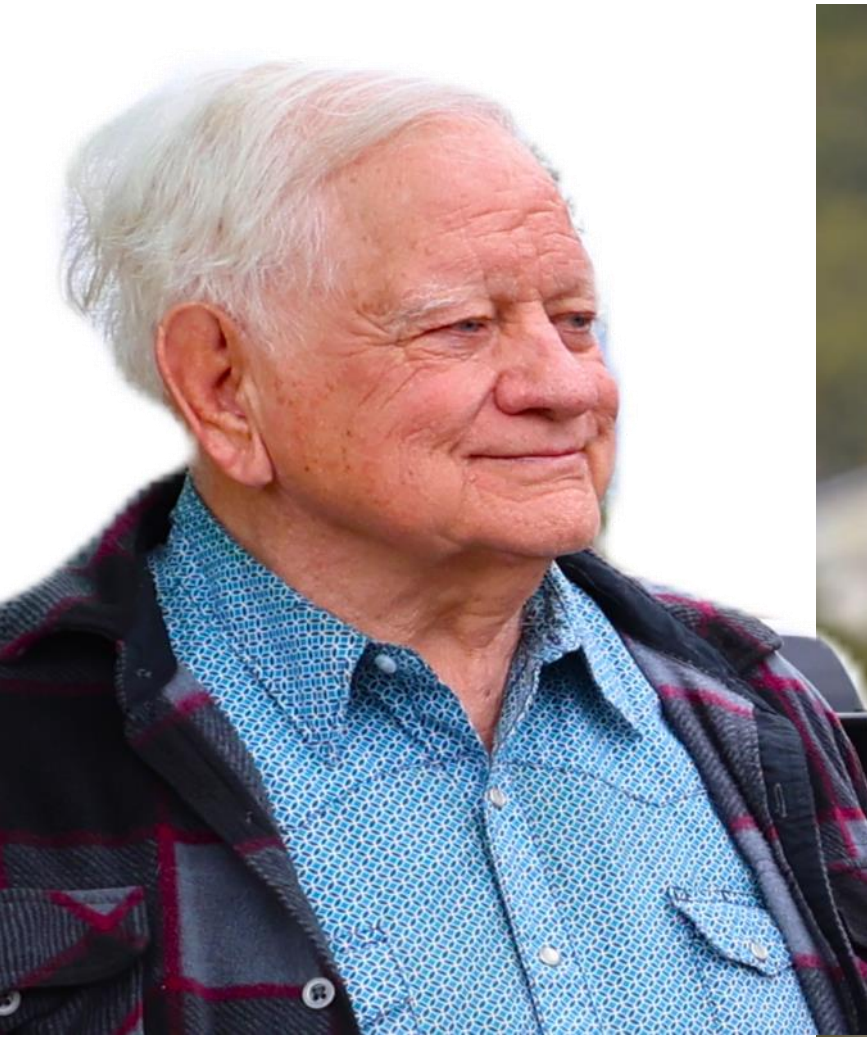

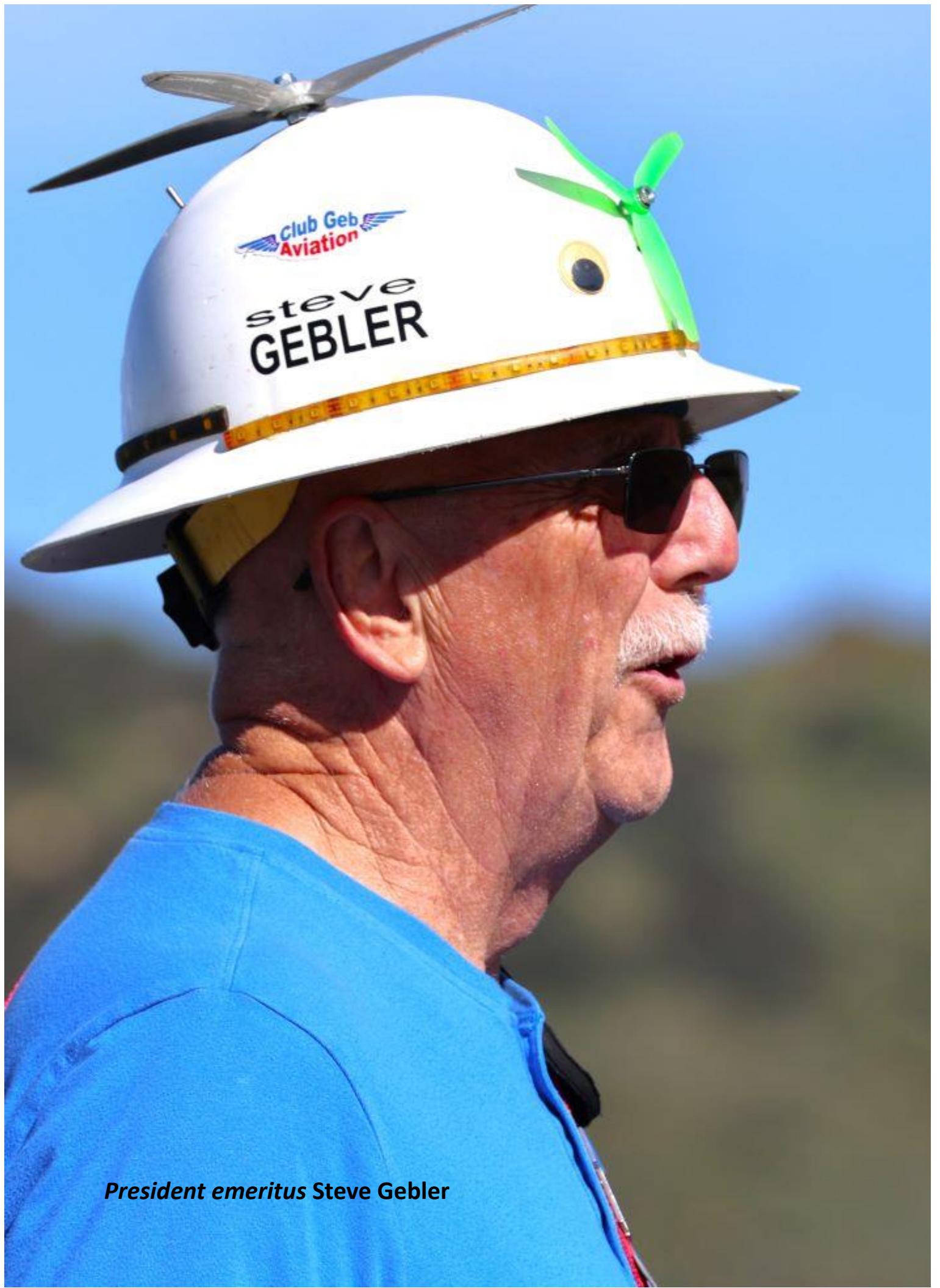

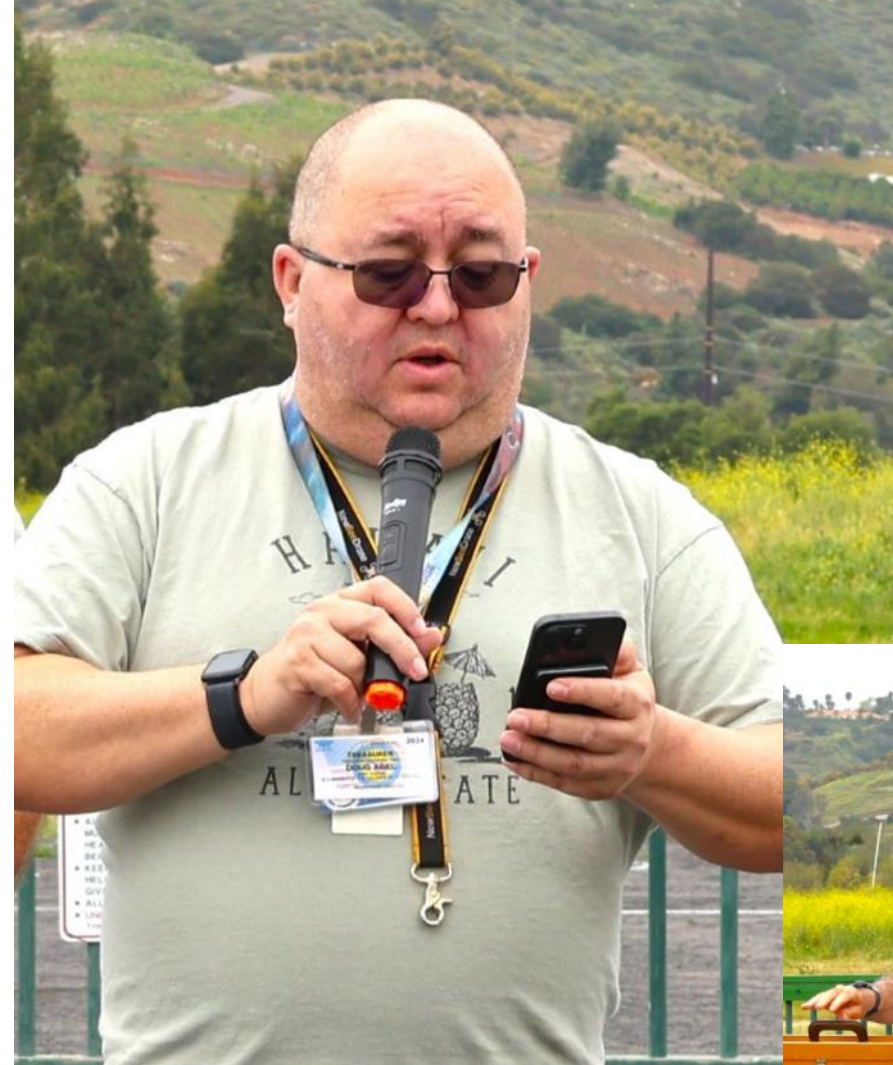
