















Frank Burke is flying this new Zen 50 (pattern type plane) from World Models that was bought at a swap meet. It has a wingspan of 54 in. and it flies well. It is powered by a Magnum 70 four-stroke glow engine with a 13 x 7 prop. It has mechanical retracts and weighs 6 lbs. 10 oz.



Joe Villarreal had a successful maiden flight with his new Revolver ARF from Great Planes. It has a wingspan of 59 in. and weighs 7 lbs. 2 oz. It is powered with an OS-75 AX two-stroke glow engine running a 12 x 8 APC prop.



Ed Ramsey had a successful maiden flight with this new P-47 Thunderbolt ARF from Hangar 9. It is powered by a Saito 125 four-stroke glow engine running a 15 x 7 prop. It has Spring Air retracts with Robart struts. The wingspan is 67 in. and it weighs 12.5 lbs.




Graham Lloyd has built this new balsa 3D Profile Mojo from Paul Swanson plans and CNC parts. It has a 52 in. wingspan and weighs 5 ½ lbs. It is powered by an OS-46-AX glow engine with a 12 x 4 prop. It has a carbon fiber rod running through the center front-to-back and has a ½ in. plywood mount for the engine. This is an American made kit, but Graham is the only one here in our club that has built one, and this is his 5th build of same. There are 8 of these flying in his club back home in the U.K.
